ASU Jazz Studies faculty members Dom Moio and Jeff Libman will describe some of the great jazz rhythm sections (usually comprised of the instruments piano, bass, drums, and sometimes guitar) and will discuss their unique styles and methods of interaction. Moio and Libman will play essential jazz recordings, lead group discussion, and will demonstrate some concepts on drums and guitar. This workshop is for jazz aficionados and anyone who wants to learn more about jazz. No instruments needed!

Instructors

Jeffrey Libman, PhD, is a clinical assistant professor of jazz studies at Arizona State University. He holds a PhD in music education from ASU. Libman is the vice president of the Board of Jazz in Arizona, the 501(c)(3) organization that opened The Nash, Phoenix's jazz performance and education center. As a jazz guitarist, Libman performs frequently in the Phoenix metropolitan area, sharing the stage with some of Arizona's finest jazz musicians. His most recent album, *Strange Beauty*, was released in late 2016 on the Cellar Live label.

Dom Moio, now in his 20th year of teaching at ASU, is a senior lecturer in the Herberger Institute for Design and the Arts. Dom teaches jazz drum set courses to jazz and classical percussion majors, and conducts the ASU Latin Jazz Ensemble. He has authored nine books including "Latin Percussion for Gringos," "Latin Percussion in Perspective" and "Be-Bop Phrasing for Drums."
